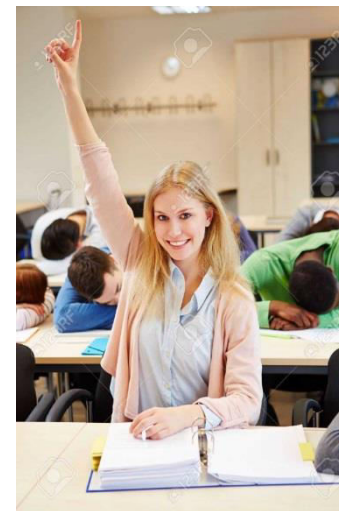

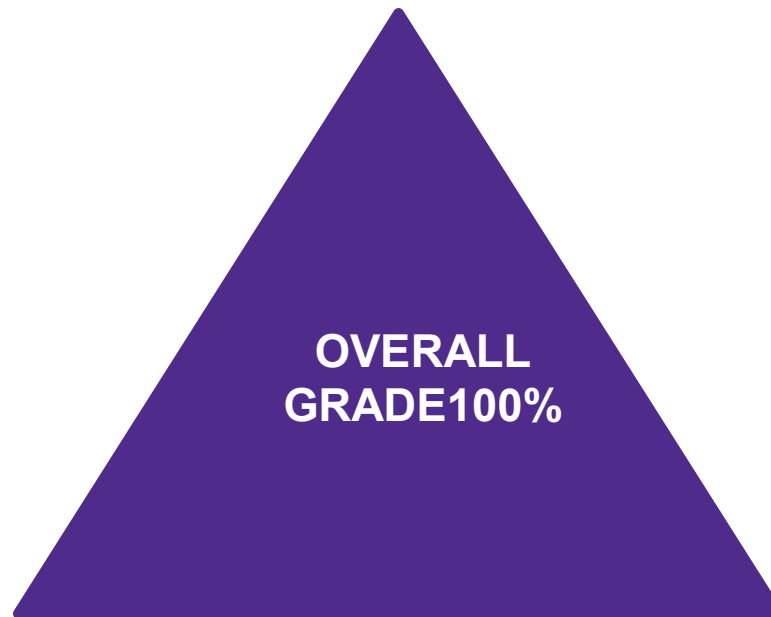

Communicative approach
